and adverse drug interactions provided by healthcare providers with widely differing backgrounds operating globally through diverse cultural references of authority creates an environment where concerns for patient safety demand transparency of professional integrity with regard to national licensure and specialty certification.

The International Board of Medicine and

Surgery's (IBMS) focus on patient safety and professional integrity is assisting patients in making more informed decisions about their global healthcare providers, and is working to protect these patients from potentially negligent opportunists.

This process by **IBMS** can only be accomplished by identifying and registering licensed healthcare professionals whose credentials including, but not limited to current state and/or national licensure, specialty certification and/or hospital affiliation (if applicable) from his/her country of medical training and practice have been reviewed in conjunction with an affidavit of compliance with standards of international medical evaluation/treatment.

These standards of international medical evaluation/treatment include but are not limited to adequate translation services, pre and post medical communication with appropriate transfer of medical records in the language of the hosted patient, screening criteria for either selecting or not selecting an appropriate candidate based on medical history, diagnostic studies and physical evaluation, anticipated detailed procedures for the treatment of minor and/or major complications as a result of medical, surgical and /or dental procedures, infection control standards including bio-waste hazards and procedure for discarding used needles, recovery center in a sanitary setting managed by medically competent personnel, and financial indemnification of patient care should complications develop upon patient's return to home country.

One of the fundamental turning points in a potential patient's decision to seek medical treatment abroad is the assurance that potential

Indemnification of complications either through an insurance company or one's own individual financial indemnification with a physician's network, the treating hospital, another provider or through a pre and post medical care treatment network for potential medical tourism complications, and a pledge to communicate clearly with the patient's medical professional in home country is an essential component in creating this assurance, and has been adopted as a criteria for IBMS Gold certification.

With standards and a pledge to abide by professional medical ethics, IBMS looks to expand the legitimacy of the physicians, surgeons, and dentists in the international global healthcare community,

Physicians, Surgeons, Dentists, Other HealthcareProfessionals, Centers of Healthcare Excellence(Clinics and Hospitals), Medical Tourism/TravelCompanies, and Professional Associations withinthe global healthcare community must continueto protect this opportunity for patients,healthcare providers, and others who participatein the medical tourism industry.

To create an environment of transparency and legitimacy, protect patient safety, and enhance professional integrity, the **International Board of Medicine and Surgery (IBMS)** needs the support of all leaders in the medical tourism industry to encourage global healthcare professionals to register with **IBMS**.

IBMS, working with our partners in the global healthcare community, will support our mutual

goals of patient safety and professional integrity, and guard them from becoming compromised.
