The position of the **International Board of Medicine** and **Surgery (IBMS)** as a *global accrediting organization seeking the finest healthcare providers in the world* is becoming more accepted.

Increased exposure through portals of social media, international forums, and word of mouth in the *global healthcare marketplace* has led to an increase in professional listings on the **IBMS Professional Online Registry** with more and more visitors to the www.ibms.us website.

Responses to the recent IBMS Global Surveys #1 and #2 have clearly indicated the desire to have an

elaborated its support for Continuing Global Medical Education (CGME) as a crucial pillar of Medical Tourism.

Highlights are as follows:

88% of respondents agree that **CGME** status and accomplishments should be conferred by a University or .formal accrediting body;

As part of a **CGME** program, **52%** of respondents support a Standardized Test of Core Information for Provider participants in *Medical Tourism*;

The greatest perceived need for CGME Courses is as follows: Emergency/Complications/Post Op Care (77%)

Potential Complications and Case Reports (73%)

Post Op/Pre Op Standards and Guidelines for International Providers (69%)

Standards for International Certification (69%)

Minimally Invasive Medical/Surgical Techniques (62%)

Infection Control Procedures (58%)

Support also extends to active participation:

77% would attend an IBMS International Meeting or Regional Event offering CGME courses;

73% are willing to represent **IBMS** in their specialty;

international professional medical organization working to accredit professional healthcare providers and create more visibility of these physicians, surgeons, and dentists and other medical professionals in the global healthcare community.

The majority of these physician, surgeon, and dentist respondents expressed an interest in having a voice in areas of continuing global medical education, the presentation of professional medical articles dealing with international aspects of medical care, the participation (and representation of IBMS) at regional medical tourism conferences, and in the IBMS Global Medical Advisory Board.

respondents specifically These surveved expressed the desire to have accredited continuing education global medical dealing with Emergencies/Complications and Post-Op Medical Care, Emerging Medical/Surgical/Dental Procedures and/or Treatments, Medical Record Management Standards for International Certification, Pre-op/Post-op Guidelines for International Providers, and Discussion of Potential Complications and Case Reports.

Members of the IBMS Global Medical Advisory Board, Dr. Kevin Huffman DO USA and Dr. Vijay Sharma MD India, are presently preparing IBMS Guidelines for Post-Operative Treatment of the Medical Tourism Patient, and the Pinellas County Medical Association (PCMA) Florida USA, an IBMS Affiliated Professional Association, has tentatively offered support in co-sponsoring and providing formal continuing medical education accreditation and has indicated a desire to publish these IBMS Guidelines and present them at an upcoming PCMA Continuing Education Program, perhaps at a regional medical tourism conference in the Tampa Bay (Florida) area.

On a related note, 62% confirm that registration of the IBMS Certification Mark with the United States Patent and Trademark Office has significant, positive standing for professional health care providers in their respective countries.

86% of those surveyed are professional Health Care workers, of whom a majority are Physicians.

Responses spanned 6 continents with many diverse countries, from Australia to Fiji, from India to Egypt, from Argentina to the USA with many in between.

Recent Consumer demand for Tattoo/Cosmetic Tattoo/Permanent Makeup has led to state licensure of Florida Tattoo/Cosmetic Tattoo/Permanent Makeup Artists,

Effective January 01, 2012.

Prior to **2012**, Florida Tattoo/Cosmetic Tattoo/Permanent Makeup Artists were statutorily required to have General Supervision by a Physician, Surgeon, or Dentist.
